Your Gig Junction page allows for up to 3 sound clips averaging 30 seconds each. The idea here is to give the potential employer a short and sweet introduction to you and your style. You are invited (and encouraged) to add a link to your website or YouTube channel to offer even more information and provide more music clips for those interested in hearing more.




Choose high-quality recordings.

No one wants to suffer through a track full of background noise. Make sure your music comes through crisp and clear.



Showcase your variety.

Don't upload three rock guitar solos. Use this space to show off the different styles and genres you can perform.



Edit wisely.

Don't get lazy with your audio clipping. Take some time and listen carefully to the whole track, and select the clip that highlights the most interesting part of the song. Make those 30 seconds count!

Solo Profile: Highlight YOUR playing

Your personal profile is about you. If you are a violist, don't include a clip of the entire symphony performing. Upload your own solo or a clip that clearly illustrates your instrument. If it's a group performance, be sure you're not drowned out.

Band Profile: Keep it real.

If this is your band profile, do your best to make sure everyone is featured in as equal measure as possible. Most importantly, be real about what the employer will get when they book you. If your sound clips features your old band with half the players no longer with the group, upload new material with the current lineup.
